Meaning of our Logo: The Symbols of Good News

Our church's logo represents more than just a visual symbol, representing the pillars of our faith and the unique good news that God has given us. Each symbol in our logo describes the four -story service that Jesus Christ has provided us and the love of the Savior God that surrounds us.

Four-Crypline Good News: Balanced, Sturdy and Endless

The term "Foursquare," the name of our church, is a powerful concept that we encounter repeatedly in the Bible. In the Book of Exodus, the depiction of the temple of the Lord and the Book of Revelation in the Book of Ezekiel, as "four-point corners," means completeness, balance, and unshakable foundation. This is where the term "Four Cornered News" inspired by our founder, Aimee Semple McPherson, was inspired by a heralring campaign in 1922. This expression emphasizes that the good news is equally balanced, solid foundations and endless in all respects. As stated in the **Hebrews 13:8, "Jesus Christ is yesterday, today and forever."** This verse reflects God's unchanging character and the power of good news.

Each symbol in our logo represents the four basic services of Jesus Christ:

One. White Cross on Red Ground: The Savior Christ

The [white cross](#) on the red ground in the upper left corner of our logo symbolizes Jesus Christ's greatest sacrifice for mankind, the atonement on the crucifix. The red color represents the spilled blood of Christ and the eternal life it offers, and the white cross represents his sinlessness and the salvation he brought to us.

*"He was also molested because of our rebellion, and he was tormented by our crimes. He was given the punishment for our peace. We have healed with his wounds."*Yeşaya 53:5

Jesus has opened the way for salvation for us by sacrificing himself for our sins. By his blood, our sins will be forgiven and we can reconcile with God. The cross is the strongest sign of this supreme salvation and God's limitless love.

Two. White Dove on the Yellow Ground: The Messiah who Baptism with the Holy Spirit

The white dove on the yellow background on the upper right corner symbolizes the Holy Spirit and the authority of Jesus Christ to baptize us with the Holy Spirit. The yellow color represents God's glory and the fire of the Holy Spirit, while the dove represents peace, purity, and the descent of the Holy Spirit.

*"So John baptised by water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit in a few days. But when the Holy Spirit lands on you, you will gain power. You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and in the fours of the world."*Elçilerin İşleri 1:5

Baptism with the Holy Spirit provides faithful ones with divine strength, wisdom, and to do God's work. This is a unique gift to us to deliver the testimony of Christ to the world.

Three. White Glass on Blue Ground: The Messiah Rehearsing

The white glass on the blue ground in the lower left corner represents the physical, spiritual, and emotional healing that Jesus Christ gave us. The blue color symbolizes life, health, and God's blessing, and heavenly color, divine power, and serenity.

Four. White Crown on Purple Ground: The Future King Christ

The white crown on the purple ground in the lower right corner symbolizes that Jesus Christ is the King and Lord who will soon return to this world. Purple color represents kingdom, nobility and sovereignty, and crown represent absolute authority, victory, and the eternal rulership of Christ.

*"By the call of an order, with the voice of the masterpiece, will descend from the sky with God's trumpet. First, the dead of Christ will be resurrected. Then we will be taken away in clouds to meet those who live, those who are alive, with them, in the air. Thus, we will be with the Lord forever."*Thessalonumians 4:16-17

This symbol reminds us of our hope and the second coming of Christ, where our eyes are waiting on the horizon. He is our King, who will return to bring justice and peace.

These four powerful symbols in our logo summarize the basic beliefs and service areas of our church:

- Jesus Christ is our savior
- Jesus Christ is the Baptizer with the Holy Spirit
- Jesus Christ is Our Healing
- Jesus Christ is our soon-to-back King

This good news **is balanced, firm, and eternal, and has the power to change the life of each individual.**

We invite you to get to know this glorious good news and to discover these unique gifts that God has given us.
